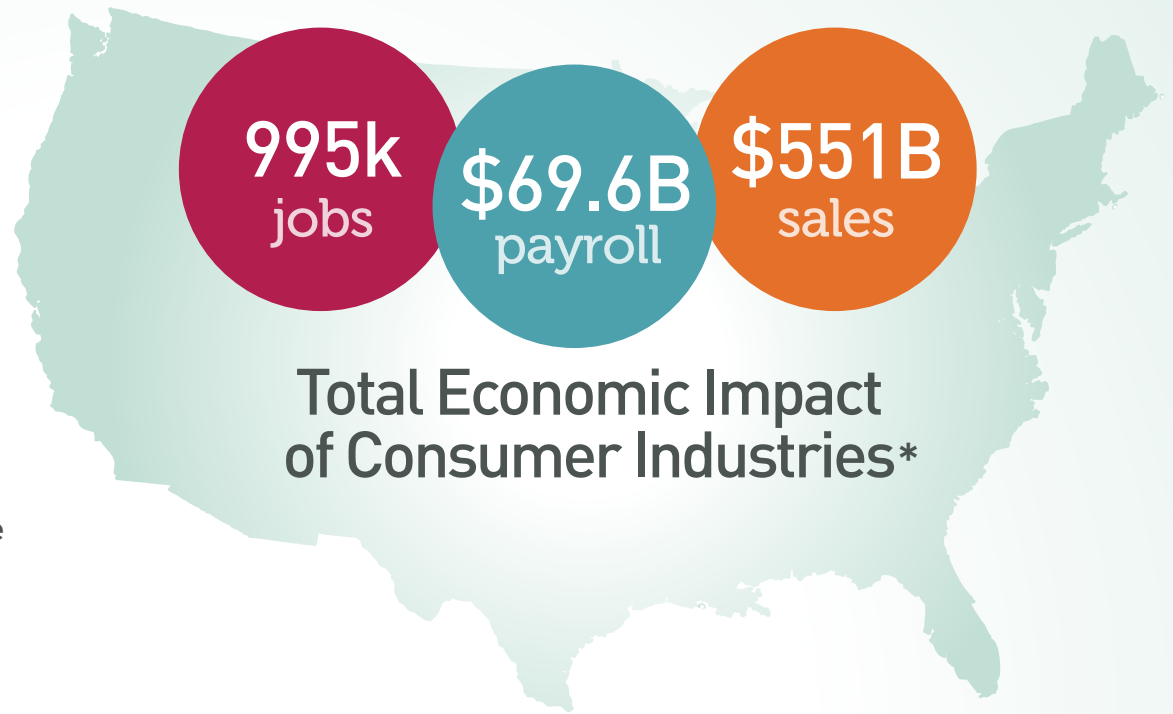


Formaldehyde Producers Boost U.S. Economy

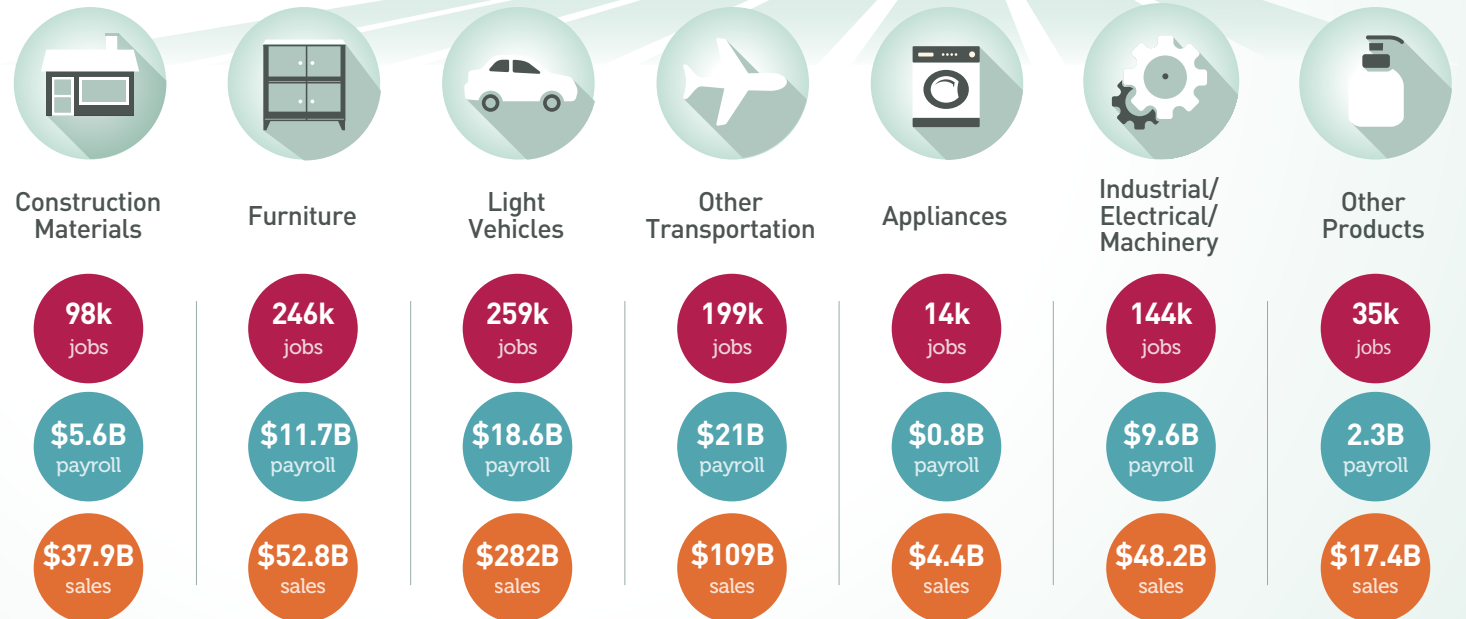
Impact Spans Key Consumer Industries

*** Indirect Impact (Supply Chain): Jobs, wages, and output created by the businesses in the supply chain that sell goods and services.
